Dominion Diamond, workers reach tentative deal

Members will now vote to ratify tentative agreement

More than 500 workers at Ekati diamond mine reached a tentative agreement with Dominion Diamond February 2. The tentative deal must now be ratified by both parties before it is accepted.

The tentative agreement contains economic increases over the course of the new four-year collective agreement and maintains existing language for vacation carry-over, severance and sick leave. The new collective agreement would expire in May 2019.

Dominion Diamond workers have been without a new collective agreement for more than 30 months.

A ratification vote will take place in March to allow all members to vote on the tentative agreement.
