



Contributing to United Way by Payroll Deduction

Payroll deduction is the easiest way to contribute to United Way NWT.

Every payday, your contribution to United Way NWT comes off your cheque, breaking the total annual donation into manageable chunks. For example, a \$100 annual donation is less than \$4 per pay.

Payroll deduction to United Way NWT is completely voluntary, can be cancelled at any time. The donation amount is recorded on your T4 for tax purposes. Your donations will be directed to projects throughout the NWT—or you can assign your donation to go to any registered charity in Canada.

In 2015, United Way NWT granted \$91,500 to 21 organizations across the NWT. By growing payroll deductions, we can help more projects reach community goals for a better NWT.

Payroll Deduction—How to Do It

- United Way NWT payroll deduction is already offered by major NWT employers. Contact your payroll department to see if your employer is signed on. They'll have all the forms.
- If your employer is not offering payroll deduction, your union local can ask to have it introduced. Talk to your Local President about getting your workplace signed on.
