



Political Action Funds

UNW allocates political action funds to Locals at a rate of \$12.50 per signed member, per annum for the purposes of engaging in educational, political, economic and other activities to advance and protect the economic and social conditions of the UNW, its members and other working people.

Locals can also apply for Special project funding up to \$2000.00 annually, if the Local is looking for more funding for a Local political campaign.

UNW Executive has a Political Action Committee that meets quarterly and promotes awareness and involvement of Union of Northern Workers members in political action and campaigns.

The Locals and Committee may promote partnerships with like-minded coalitions and labour organizations like CLC, Status of Women, NTFI, PSAC North and aboriginal groups.
